Items needed for disaster relief

Bottled water, canned and other non-perishable foods

Bagged rice and beans

Diapers, wipes and baby care items

Personal hygiene items (soaps, shampoos, feminine hygiene items)

Paper towels and toilet paper

Large trash bags

Over the counter medications (Aspirin, Tylenol, Ibuprofen – adult and children strength)

Antibiotic creams and ointments (Neosporin, etc.)
